## “Building Community Through Service”

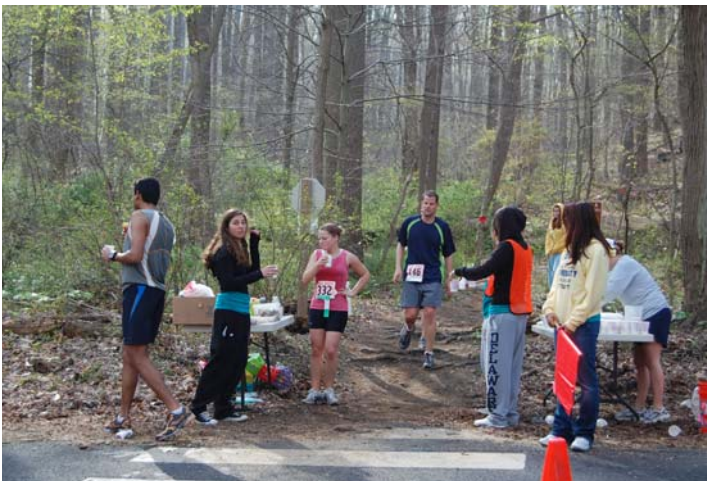
On April 25, 2009 a diverse group of students and leaders began a new chapter in the life of our campus ministry.
